

Appendix 1 - Reward System

We believe that pupils will make positive behaviour choices because they strive for excellence in how they conduct themselves. They will have an intrinsic motivation to meet the core values and will feel a sense of pride in knowing that they are a positive member of the school community.

We celebrate positive behaviours in a range of ways:

- Awarding house points/DOJO points
- Recognising achievements in school celebration assembly
- Inviting parents in to celebrate success
- Messages home to parents

A house point system is used across the school from Reception to Year 6, including Blossom Grove. There are 4 houses and children will remain in a set house for their time at All Saints. We have heads of house and deputy heads of house that are voted for and chosen by pupils and staff. Throughout the year we also hold various house competitions led by pupil ambassadors.

Badges and rewards

Pupils will receive badges for the amount of house points they personally receive to display on their lanyard of achievement which they will wear to assembly every Friday and take class to class with them for each year they move up year group. Per year, these are the badges awarded to children:

50 points	Blue
100 points	Red
150 points	Green
200 points	Yellow
250 points	Bronze
300 points	Silver
350 points	Gold

Badges will also be awarded for showing christian values, sporting achievements, effort in specific subjects and for holding roles of responsibility around the school. *More can always be added at the discretion of the school where necessary.*

By children being awarded something tangible for their achievements, we hope that children will aspire to fill their lanyard of achievement and look back at their achievements with pride every year.
